Dr. Laura Gottlieb recently received a 3-year grant from Kaiser Permanente to develop a Social Interventions Research and Evaluation Network (SIREN), which will be a national initiative to synthesize, disseminate, and catalyze new research at the intersection of social and medical care. Laura is working with Nancy Adler, PhD, Director of the Center for Health and Community at UCSF.

Dr. Danielle Hessler-Jones and **Dr. Michael Potter** have received a 5-year R18 grant award from the National Institutes of Health (NIH) to study the impact of adding a patient engagement protocol to the existing self-management support tool called Connection to Health on self-management behaviors and glycemic control in resource-limited community health centers.

Dr. Jack Chase has received a Hellman Family Award for early career development to study electronic health record (EHR)-based care transitions from hospital to community. The award was announced in late May. This is a continuation of the care transitions work Jack started on Family Medicine Inpatient Service which will be rolled out hospital-wide in a few months.

Focus On: Laura Gottlieb, MD, MPH

Laura Gottlieb, MD, MPH, is Assistant Professor of Family and Community Medicine at the University of California, San Francisco. Dr. Gottlieb's current research focuses on designing and evaluating methods to integrate interventions to address social factors into health care. These interventions include volunteer-powered social services Help Desks, Medical-Legal Partnerships and other efforts to identify and address social needs in medical practices, like re-designing electronic medical records to incorporate data on social determinants; increasing patient enrollment in county income and food benefits; and improving social work capacity. Dr. Gottlieb is also a co-founder of [HealthBegins](#), a non-profit organization providing education, consulting, networking, and technology services to health care providers interested in joining the effort to move medicine upstream. She also founded the Bay Area Help Desk Consortium, a collaboration between multiple hospitals, legal aid, and university groups investing in volunteer Help Desks in Bay Area health systems
