Abstract Submission Instructions

1. **Submission Deadline:** Abstracts must be received by **Friday, January 23, 2026, 5pm.**
2. **Organization of Abstracts:** The abstract should be organized as follows:
 - A) Context and Objective (Why did you do your project?)
 - B) Setting/Populations (Where and with whom did you do your project?)
 - C) Intervention/Study Design (What did you do?)
 - D) Outcomes/Results (What you learned from what you did?)
 - E) Conclusions (One or two key 'take home' messages about what you did)
3. **Abstract Length:** The maximum length of a poster/oral presentation abstract submitted for the 2026 FCM Rodnick Colloquium is **350 words.**

IMPORTANT: Before you start submitting your abstract, please check to confirm (i.e., using Microsoft Word's word count tool) that the text of your abstract does not exceed 350 words (do not include title, authors, and section titles in your word count). This abstract submission program will allow you to enter more words than the limit, but if the text of your abstract exceeds 350 words, we will not be able to consider it.

4. **Presentation Preference:** You will be asked whether you want to present only in person or virtually. Please confirm your choice with all presenters prior to submitting your response.
5. **Title Listing:** Capitalize only the first word on your title. Please do not use abbreviations.
6. **Author Listing:** List authors in this format: Last Name, First Initial and Include an Asterisk (*) next to presenting/first author.
7. Optional **Abstract Submission Form:** At the end of the submission form, you will have the option to review and complete the following form **FCM Anti-Racism Guidelines for Colloquium Presenters.**


