 <p>New rural program in underserved area</p> <p>Mendocino/Lake counties are poorer and sicker than most other California counties.</p> <p>40% residents “not confident” in addressing SDoH</p> <p>>50% residents do not currently screen for SDoH</p>	<p>4 week curriculum embedded into PGY1 community medicine rotation to start July 2021</p> <p>Goals and objectives based on Entrustable Professional Activities (EPA's)</p> <p>Two Parts: Content and Experiential modules</p> 	 <p>Pre- and post- resident surveys</p> <p>Track patients being screened/ number of referrals placed</p> <p>Post-course reflective discussion</p>	<p>No gold standard for how to teach SDoH</p> <p>Adapting curriculum to meet particular needs of a new program and its patient population</p> <p>Invoking change management</p>
